

## VANCOUVER CANUCKS "ROCK THE ROG ANTHEM AND TALENT SEARCH" CONTEST

### RULES AND REGULATIONS

These Official Contest Rules and Regulations (the "Rules") apply to the Vancouver Canucks Rock the Rog Anthem and Talent Search, presented by Klipsch (Gentec International). The contest is operated and sponsored by Canucks Sports & Entertainment ("CSE"). By participating in the contest, entrants fully and unconditionally accept and agree to comply with the Rules. The Rules (and any CSE decision relating to the application, interpretation and enforcement of the Rules) are final and binding with respect to all matters relating to the contest.

1. **Contest Eligibility.** The contest is open to individuals of any age legally residing in Canada (other than the Province of Quebec). Entrants under nineteen (19) years of age ("Minors") may participate with the consent of a parent or legal guardian, which shall be confirmed by submission at the time of entry and further confirmed in writing prior to the award of any prize. Employees, officers and directors of CSE and Gentec International Inc. or their affiliates (and the immediate family members of such persons) are not eligible to enter. For purposes of this Contest, "immediate family members" means parents, spouses, children, siblings, in-laws and grandparents.

2. **How to Enter and Participate.** NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS CONTEST. To enter, create one (1) unedited video of 3-5 minutes in length (a "Video Submission") that best demonstrates your performance of the Canadian and United States national anthem and/or other musical talents and abilities. Go to [www.canucks.com/contests](http://www.canucks.com/contests) to submit your Video Submission by providing us with a URL to your video on a file sharing service. To upload a Video Submission to a file sharing service, you must be a registered user of that service. To become a registered user of a file sharing service, you must register for an account and agree to the service provider's "Terms of Service". For the purpose of this contest, a Video Submission is a video file created specifically for this contest that follows the submission requirements specified in these Rules. Video Submissions may be submitted at any time during the Contest Period. Limit one (1) Video Submission per entrant. Video Submissions must be submitted only by a single entrant. Group Video Submissions will not be accepted (e.g., although different individuals might have taken part in the making of a Video Submission, and /or more than one individual may star in the Video Submission, only one individual may be considered to have produced and submitted the Video Submission).

3. **Contest Period and Winner Selection.** Video Submissions must be received during the period commencing August 6, 2013 at 5:00 p.m. Pacific Standard Time ("PST") and ending on August 18, 2013 at 4:59 p.m. PST (the "Contest Period"). All Video Submissions received during the Contest Period which meet the eligibility criteria and other requirements set out in these Rules will be judged by a panel of representatives from CSE. The CSE judges will determine, in their sole and absolute discretion, the top twenty (20) Video Submissions received and will then identify these Video Submissions on [www.canucks.com](http://www.canucks.com) and invite fans to vote for their favourite Video Submission. Fan voting online will be conducted between August 19, 2013 and August 23, 2013. The entrants for the top ten (10) Video Submissions, as determined by fan voting during the fan voting period, will be invited to Rogers Arena for a live audition between September 9, 2013 and September 13, 2013. The live auditions will be recorded and streamed on [www.canucks.com](http://www.canucks.com) either live or at a later time to be determined by CSE. CSE will select the grand prize winner in its sole discretion from among the live audition participants. Grand prize winner will be announced the week of September 16, 2013. The odds of being selected as the grand prize winner or of winning any other prize depends on the number of entries received.

4. **Prizes.** The grand prize winner will be provided with the opportunity to sing the Canadian and/or U.S. national anthems at a 2013-14 regular season Vancouver Canucks home game. The grand prize winner will also be provided with a Klipsch Home Theatre Package, valued at \$1,100.00. The Runner-Up will receive a Klipsch KMC3 Music Centre, valued at \$399.00. Each of the top 10 finalists will receive a pair of Klipsch Overear Headphones, valued at \$159.00. Each of the twenty semi-finalists will receive a pair of Klipsch Graphite Earbuds, valued at \$69.00. All prizes are non-negotiable, non-transferable and may not be substituted for cash. If for any reason, the winner is unable to accept a prize as awarded, the winner forfeits his/her right to the prize without compensation.

5. **Video Submission Requirements.** Video Submissions must comply with the following requirements:

- i) Video Submissions must not reveal any personal information about another individual, including another person's address, phone number, e-mail address, credit card number or any information that may be used to track, contact or impersonate that individual;
- ii) Video Submissions must not contain profanity, pornographic, or sexual content, content relating to alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco, firearms, or weapons, hateful content of any kind (including racism, sexism, etc.), content that promotes violence or harm to another living creature, or any other offensive, obscene, or inappropriate content;
- iii) Video Submissions must not defame, misrepresent, or contain disparaging remarks about other people, cities or entities, including, but not limited to, CSE, or any former or current Vancouver Canucks player;
- iv) Video Submissions must not promote a political agenda regardless of the political affiliation;
- v) Video Submissions must not contain materials embodying the names, likenesses, photographs, or other identifying elements of any person, living or dead, without having obtained permission and authorization ;
- vi) Video Submissions must not include trademarks, logos, or copyrighted material not owned by the entrant unless the copyright owner has consented to the submission or been given appropriate credit as the copyright owner within the Video Submission; and
- vii) if Video Submissions are made by providing CSE with a link to a file sharing site, entrant must also comply with the terms of service for that file sharing site..

CSE and/or its designated representatives will review all Video Submissions received during the contest Period and may reject and disqualify from the contest any Video Submission not conforming to the above or otherwise not conforming to these Rules, as determined by CSE in its sole and absolute discretion.

6. **Ownership of all Video Submissions.** By submitting a Video Submission, entrants hereby assign to CSE all rights, title and interest in and to the Video Submission, including the right to use, reproduce and distribute the Video Submission or any part thereof in any media whatsoever, now known or hereafter created, without any further consent or compensation. Video Submissions may be used by CSE, and, with CSE's permission, its affiliates and agents, on any media, without limitation. For all these purposes, the entrant hereby waives any and all copyright interest, and any moral rights, of any nature or kind they may have in the Video Submission.

7. **Contestant Representations.** This contest is void where prohibited. By submitting a Video Submission, the entrant agrees that he or she has read, understood and agrees with these Rules.

Further, by submitting a Video Submission via link to a file sharing service, the entrant hereby warrants that the Video Submission, and all elements thereof satisfy the terms and conditions of the file sharing service and further warrant that the Video Submission in this contest:

- i) is the original work of the entrant (or a cover of the original work of another for whom credit has been given in the Video Submission);
- ii) has not previously been published or won an award or prize of any kind;
- iii) does not infringe or violate the rights of any third party, including, but not limited to, copyrights, trademarks, patents, trade secrets, logos, contract and licensing rights, rights of publicity or privacy, moral rights, or any other intellectual property rights;
- iv) is not subject to any third party agreements, and that CSE will not be required to pay or incur any sums to any person or entity as a result of their use, exhibition or exploitation of the idea or video or elements therein;
- v) does not contain any content that is likely to be considered offensive by CSE or could adversely affect the name, reputation, or goodwill of CSE

By submitting to the Contest, each entrant represents and warrants that he or she has obtained all of the rights, licenses, and permissions from each person who appeared in or helped to create the Video Submission. If CSE, in its sole discretion, determines that an entrant has breached a representation or warranty, the Video Submission will be disqualified.

**8. Release of Liability.** None of Vancouver Canucks Limited Partnership, Vancouver Arena Limited Partnership, Gentec International Inc., or any of their respective affiliates and each of their respective officers, directors, shareholders, agents and employees, nor any Internet access providers or file sharing services (collectively "Released Parties") shall have any liability or responsibility whatsoever to entrants related to problems uploading or downloading any contest-related materials, or for late, lost, damaged, misdirected, incorrect or incomplete Video Submissions, including for or by reason of any incorrect or inaccurate entry of information, human error, technical malfunction, lost/delayed data transmission, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, line failure of any telephone, computer or other network, computer equipment, software or any combination thereof, inability to access the file sharing service or otherwise. Any entry information collected from the contest shall be used only in a manner consistent with the consent given by entrants at the time of entry, with these Rules, and with the terms of the privacy policy of CSE.
